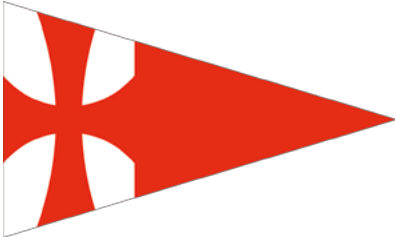

CRUISING YACHT COURSE CROATIA 2022



The MRCY Baiona school in collaboration with Julio Verne Náutica offers you a week long navigation course in Croatia where we will mix training, tourism and adventure.

The course is focused on skippers and crew to increase their confidence and security to enjoy a sailing yacht.

Skippers, trained to sail with their crew safely and enjoying it. Crew members, seeking to be a competent helping hand on board and being able to work as a team with the skipper.

The skipper and crew positions will rotate among the students and the skippers will have to make all decisions throughout the 24 hours of the day.

Each day will have a theoretical part, a lot of practice and also moments to enjoy the landscape.

Recommended minimum level*: It is recommended that students know the basic nomenclature on board, are able to steer a course in different directions and in moderate weather conditions, and finally, that they are accustomed to the basic maneuvers on board.

Examples:

- Nautical graduates from PER, Day Skipper, SKS etc.
- Sailors with real sailing experience.
- Students of cruise sailing courses.

** In case you do not have the recommended level we suggest at least one navigation course at MRCY prior to this course.*

SYLLABUS /

TRAVEL PLANNING: How to plan, where to find destination information, which route to choose depending on the weather and capabilities/wishes of the crew, where to find information.

How to prepare trips from home.

NAVIGATION: Improve governance by adapting technique to weather conditions. Dangers and advantages of each course to steer depending on the sea state and wind conditions in cruise mode (looking for the tranquility and comfort of the crew). Night navigation. Consumption and motor autonomy.

LIFE ON BOARD: How does life on board work and how it is managed: Electricity management, water reserves, fuel,...Use of kitchen, bathrooms, cleaning, general order, provisioning, managing sea sickness, waste treatment.

SKIPPERING: Each day a student will be the skipper and will have to plan, manage and make decisions.

CREW MANAGEMENT: Security briefing, how to command, teach and transmit safety and confidence to the crew on board. Weather forecast interpretation. Digital media, local conditions.

SOLVING PROBLEMS AND ADVERSITIES ON BOARD: Problems with the sails, lines wrapped around the propeller, crossed anchors, battery failure, MOB etc.

MOORING: Mooring techniques, use and function of each line while docking, crew organization. We will practice the entire week.

ANCHORING: How, where and precautions to anchor. Anchoring for the day as well as when preparing to spend the night. Electronic aids. precautions with the neighbors.

SAILBOAT CHARTER: Where to rent Mediterranean - Caribbean - Atlantic, when to rent, how to choose a boat and company, prices and extras, what to take into account when renting.

NAVIGATION AREA /

Adriatic Sea, Central Croatia.

Saturday June 11th we'll sleep in the marina and have to disembark at 09:00 a.m.

Day 6: Scedro-Hvar	15 miles
Day 7: Hvar-Split	25 miles
TOTAL	120 miles
